The elementary reading program is very challenging; the texts contain advanced vocabulary and sentence structure, and the comprehension work requires textual analysis in all grades. 1st and 2nd graders (as well as upper elementary students whose word attacks skills need to be strengthened) read the text multiple times, orally. After reading the text, all the students independently answer comprehension questions about their reading, support their answers from the text, and rework poor answers. Classic literature is also read daily by the teachers to their classes. Additional extracurricular reading of classic books is required.
